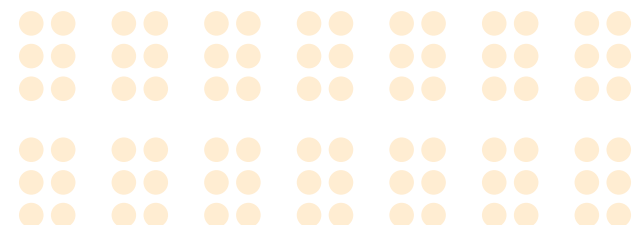

to feel the dots with your fingers.



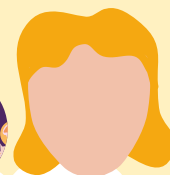
Sweet & sour

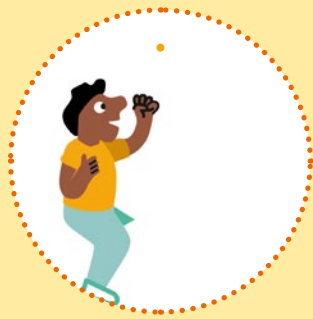

4. Then rub the stick back and forth quickly between your hands.

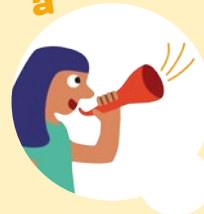

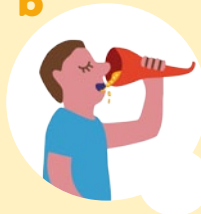

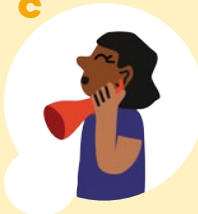
